**ITEM No.1: Confirmation of the Minutes of the Meeting of 184<sup>th</sup> meeting of National Monuments Authority (NMA) held on 12-07-2018 and 13-07-2018**

It was observed that notes have been received on the draft minutes from Sh. U.K. Sadhav, Whole Time Member (WTM) and Sh. Satish Kumar, Whole Time Member (WTM). The notes were discussed and it was explained that the Heritage Bye Laws of Amjad Ali Shah's Mosqourium, Lucknow was approved in 181<sup>st</sup> meeting of NMA held on 05-06-2018 and sent to Ministry Of Culture. The Ministry approved the Heritage Bye Laws and referred it to Ministry of Law. It has been explained that as per the minutes of 183<sup>rd</sup> meeting of NMA, (Additional Agenda), the supplementary documents received from Government of Uttar Pradesh have been placed on records and will be added to the Heritage Bye Laws after the same is received back from Ministry of Culture. This will be included in the minutes of 184<sup>th</sup> meeting of NMA at Agenda Item No.3. The notes written by Shri Satish Kumar, Whole Time Member and Shri U.K. Sadhav, Whole Time Member regarding Heritage Bye Laws of Amjad Ali Shah's Tomb were discussed on 12/7/2018. It was reiterated that the earlier decision of National Monuments Authority to approve these Heritage Bye Laws cannot be revisited.

**ITEM No. 2: Online cases (Non- Single Window)**

These two Online cases (NON- Single Window) received from Tamil Nadu were discussed. Sh. U.K. Sadhav, WTM pointed out that as per the notification issued by Ministry Of

Culture, the online applications are to be processed only after the database and Heritage Bye Laws (HBL'S) are available online. No database and HBL's in respect of any monument is available online as on date. Therefore, no new city can be included in Online Approval System till the time all the information prescribed in the notification dated 05-02-2016 is made available.

It was further observed that recommendation of Competent Authority, Tamil Nadu is also not available for these 2 (two) cases.

Sh. Satish Kumar, WTM endorsed the views of Sh. U.K. Sadhav.

Sh. A.B. Shukla, WTM stated that since this is a very small plot with 81.52 sq meters area and is at a distance of 290 meters from Centrally Protected Monument and causing no threat to the integrity of the monument, NOC may be recommended in the first case.

Member Secretary, NMA pointed out that all the information/ documents required in case of offline applications are also obtained in online cases. Secondly, the time frame of 72 hours for processing and disposal of the online cases can be extended by both CA and NMA citing reasons thereof.

Chairperson, NMA stated that since NMA is adopting the same procedure in both online and offline cases, NMA may continue with considering online cases received through NMA portal.

After discussion, the following decisions were taken:

- i) Since there is diversion of views in NMA on policy issues, the matter may be referred to Ministry of Culture for taking a view with regard to submission of Online Applications till the database and HBL's are made available.
- ii) Till such time, a response is received from Ministry of Culture, no online Application received through NMA Portal (Non- Single Window) shall be considered by NMA. However, this will not be applicable for those cases where the applications are being forwarded through Single Window Clearance System.
- iii) These 2 cases may be treated as offline cases and may be submitted for consideration of NMA after obtaining specific recommendation of CA, Tamil Nadu.
- iv) The Competent Authorities may be directed to make specific recommendation while forwarding NOC application.
